HISTORY

Ramakrishna Math, Viveknagar had its humble beginning on 29 May 1989 through taking over the Assets and Properties including about 15 acres of land, donated by erstwhile 'Sri Ramakrishna Sevashrama' Amtali, that was organized by Swami Paramananda (a monk not belonging to the Ramakrishna Order attached to Ramakrishna Math, Belur), since 13 December 1966. It is 8 km to the south of Agartala, the capital town of the Tripura. Since inception of the new Math complex was renamed 'Viveknagar' as per official records of the Govt. of Tripura, and the name 'Viveknagar' is in regular use by the people of the area now. An Extra-Departmental Post Office for the locality is located at Viveknagar.

Activities during the year 2016 – 2017

Vocational Training in Rubber Tapping

A 'Rubber Tapping Training School', is run by Math in collaboration with the Regional Rubber Board since ----- . It trained in 06 (six) batches of 84 (S.T. – 57, S.C. – 07, O.B.C. – 14 and Gen – 06) Tribal and Non-tribal youths belonging to the rural areas in the current year. Tripura is now the second largest rubber producing State in India. The trained youths from this centre have been using this skill either in tending their own garden or working other's garden as skilled labourer and earning sufficiently.

Regular activities and celebrations

Daily worship, evening prayer and Ramnam Sankirtan on Ekadashi days (since 2002) in the Temple were conducted regularly in addition to observance of Birthday Tithi Puja of direct disciples of Sri Ramakrishna followed by short discourse after evening prayer. It is attended mostly by resident students and a few staff.

Sankara Jayanti was observed with discourse on the life and teachings of Acharya Sankara on 11-05-2016 at the shrine.

Buddha Jayanti was observed with discourses on the life and teachings of the Buddha on 21-05-2016 at the shrine.

Guru Purnima (Birthday of Vyasadeva) was observed on 19-07-2016 with discourses on the life and teachings of the Vyasadeva at the shrine.

Janmastami was observed with devotional songs and discourse on the life of Sri Krishna on 25-08-2016 at the shrine.

On 05 March 2017, **public celebration** in connection with **Sri Ramakrishna's Birthday** was held at Viveknagar with usual day-long program that included

(i) Morning procession, (ii) special puja, homa, (iii) devotional songs, instrumental music, readings from Ramakrishna Punthi and various religious scriptures and short religious discourse (iv) distribution of cooked Prasad.

The special event of the celebration was **Ramakrishna Mela** with about 300 stalls, which drew a large crowd. About 8,000 devotees were served with cooked Prasad in plates at noon. The event of day-long reading program from various scriptures and biographies of saints of major religions of the world was, as usual, highly appreciated. The weather was clear and pleasant. Students, members of the staff with their family members, devotees and admirers attended the morning procession which started at 6.30 a.m.

A drama **Yugavatar Sri Ramakrishna** was performed by Sri Sri Ramakrishna Ashrama, Khowai.

Monthly Special Study Circle (Pathachakra)
